Rules and Regulations

These rules and regulations are meant to ensure the continued safety for all who enter the cemetery grounds and to facilitate proper care of the cemetery. Please be respectful of others at all times.

- No Pets allowed on cemetery grounds.
- Permitted items include but not limited to: flower pot holders, remembrance lights, statues and personal mementos. All items need to be at least six inches tall.
- Prohibited items include articles of clothing, glass containers, homemade planters and alcohol.
- Planting of flowers, trees or shrubs is not allowed.
- Items in compliance may be placed on graves between April 1 and October 1.
- Limit of two items per marker. In-ground flower vase does not count as one of your items.
- Christmas items are allowed on graves from December 1 through the Solemnity of the Epiphany. Items must be removed by Epiphany Sunday. (The Sunday that falls between January 2 and January 8.)
- No items are to be attached to the Columbarium or to trees.
- Epiphany will remove items that are out of compliance or show signs of deterioration.
- The cemetery staff will remove all items left on the graves after October 1 and discard them.
- Epiphany is not responsible for items that have been removed.
