Extreme Faith Camp – Middle School Participant Expectations

EFC is a unique ministry opportunity for our youth. It is a chance for rising 7th-9th graders to enter deeply into a retreat atmosphere and grow deeper in their relationship with Jesus Christ through prayer, fellowship, and an experience of the Sacraments that, for many, is unlike what they have experienced before. This being said, the teens that attend should have a desire to participate and will act in accord with the few expectations we have of participants:

1. Attend and do your best to fully enter into every session, talk, small group time, prayer time, etc. Investment is key, you can only get out what you are willing to put in!
2. ***Leave your cell phone at home!*** You will not have service anyway, there will be people to wake you up, so you don't need an alarm, and it will probably get broken. Just leave it at home!
3. Follow instructions of all youth ministers, camp staff, any other adult or any high school Extreme Team members. We are there to make sure you have fun AND to keep you safe!
4. Commit to building relationships with your roommates, small group members, small group leaders, and other people at camp. **MAKE NEW FRIENDS!!** It's one of the best parts of camp.
5. Know that myself and all the youth ministers at camp are here for you as well as all the high school leaders. We will all support you in any way you might need, and are always there to talk through things, or just hang out with you!
6. Follow all of the rules set out for campers by youth ministers and camp staff, attend all meetings and sessions, and follow appropriate behavior, including camp dress code:

Dress Code for Girls: _____ initial here

- Shirts: No lowcut tops, crop tops, open backs, visible bra straps, or spaghetti straps.
- No leggings, jeggings, yoga pants, or exercise tights.
- Shorts: Hem must be at least mid-thigh length. If you have specific questions about that, ask Carly.
- Bathing suits: One-piece and tankini suits are acceptable. If you only have a two-piece, a tank top or t-shirt must be worn over it.

Dress Code for Boys: _____ initial here

- Shirts: must remain on unless swimming.
- Pants: must always cover all undergarments. No leggings or exercise tights. Tears in jeans must follow rules for shorts.
- Shorts: Hem must be at least to the length of your fingertips when your arms are relaxed at your side. No running shorts.
- Bathing suits should follow the shorts rule.

I understand and agree to these expectations and that if any of these terms are violated, Church of the Epiphany can send the participant home at the participant/guardian's expense.
