Extreme Faith Camp – Prayer Team and Extreme Team Expectations

We expect our high school students to be examples for our middle school students of what it looks like to pursue virtue and holiness, leading the middle schoolers first and foremost by example to a life with Christ. That being said, here are some specific expectations we have for Prayer Team and Extreme Team members leading up to and while participating in Extreme Faith Camp:

1. Continue, or begin, to cultivate a consistent personal prayer life. We cannot give what we don't have when we are ministering to middle schoolers, so in order to lead you must pray.
2. Be enthusiastic and excited about all of the activities at EFC, from icebreaker games to Mass and everything in between.
3. Commit to building relationships with the middle schoolers in your small group and cabin through meaningful interactions throughout the week.
4. Know that if you have friends who are also on Extreme Team, you will not be spending time with them during the camp week.
5. If on Prayer Team, fully enter into all of the activities you will do together as a group.
6. Have respect for and show obedience to any and all youth ministers or adult chaperones at EFC.
7. Know that all the youth ministers at camp are here for you as well as the Middle Schoolers! We will all support you in any way you might need.
8. Follow all of the rules set out for campers, attend all meetings and sessions, and model appropriate behavior, including camp dress code:

Dress Code for Girls: _____ initial here

- Shirts: No lowcut tops, crop tops, open backs, visible bra straps, or spaghetti straps.
- No leggings, jeggings, yoga pants, or exercise tights.
- Shorts: Hem must be at least mid-thigh length. If you have specific questions about that, ask Carly.
- Bathing suits: One-piece and tankini suits are acceptable. If you only have a two-piece, a tank top or t-shirt must be worn over it.

Dress Code for Boys: _____ initial here

- Shirts: must remain on unless swimming.
- Pants: must always cover all undergarments. No leggings or exercise tights. Tears in jeans must follow rules for shorts.
- Shorts: Hem must be at least to the length of your fingertips when your arms are relaxed at your side. No running shorts.
- Bathing suits should follow the shorts rule.

I understand and agree to these expectations and that if any of these terms are violated, Church of the Epiphany can send the participant home at the participant/guardian's expense.
