



Parents and Guardians,

Congratulations on receiving a child into your life! The Catholic Church shares in your joy as you bring forth the child to the Sacrament of Baptism.

At the Church of the Epiphany we honor your role as parents/guardians and seek to support you in the faith development and experience of the child and family. Therefore, we ask that you **register in our parish community** and join in the sacramental and community life here. To register, go to www.epiphanymn.org and click on "join us".

In addition to registration, a **Baptism Preparation Class** is required for all parents/guardians. Godparents are welcome to attend. This class will prepare you on the theology of the sacrament, go over the Rite of Baptism that you will celebrate and set a path toward fulfilling the vow to raising the child in the faith. See below for more information. If you have attended this class within the last 4 years and are active in your faith, you do not need to repeat the class.

Parents presenting a child age 2-6 will need to schedule for their child an orientation session with Dana Butler. This session aims to provide instruction for the child and make them feel comfortable and prepared to receive the sacrament. Depending on the age of the child, this orientation session is about 30-60 minutes in length and may need more than one date of orientation.

In order to sign up for a Baptism, complete the **Baptismal Registration Form** and bring a copy (or the original and we'll make a copy) of the child's **birth certificate** to the Parish Office at least two weeks before the requested celebration date. We ask for a two week notice in scheduling your baptism. This will ensure that the number of baptisms is limited to provide for a reverent atmosphere for the sacrament. A baptismal certificate will be issued to you at the baptism.

Baptism Preparation Class at 10:00-11:00am in the Parish Office unless noted.

2022: June 4, August 6, September 3, October 1, November 5, December 3

2023: January 7, February 4, March 4, April 1, May 6, June 3

Registration reservation is needed for the class. Please allow 2 weeks before your intended celebration date as information from the class may alter any initial plans. Contact Dana to preregister. The class is for adults. If you need to bring your child(ren), please have another adult who can attend to their needs if needed during the class.

Baptisms are celebrated on two Sundays a month. Upcoming Baptism celebrations:

2022: June 12 and 26, August 14 & 28, September 11 & 25, October 9 & 23, November 13 & 27, December 4 & 18

2023: January 8 & 22, February 12 & 26, March 12 & 26, April 23, May 7 & 21, June 11 & 25

One godparent is required. Two godparents can be name, one male and one female. A godparent must be 16 years of age or older, a confirmed and practicing member of the Catholic Church. If you are in need of a godparent, we will help to find for your child a godparent. The church allows for a baptized Christian (non-Catholic) to be a witness at the ceremony in addition to the named godparent (must have one Catholic godparent) if needed.
