

Extreme Faith Camp FAQ

What is Extreme Faith Camp?

Extreme Faith Camp is a premier high adventure camp packed with incredible activities. High ropes, lasertag, zip lines, climbing walls, and more. Extreme Faith Camp is led by parishes from the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis, guaranteeing that summer camp is not just a mountaintop faith experience, but one that builds lifelong foundations of faith. Our faith programming is founded in the sacramental life of the Catholic Church, and our mission and work is anything but boring. This summer, Extreme Faith Camp will be at Trinity Woods Camp in Trego, WI.

What grades are allowed to go?

Camp registration is open to all current (2023-2024 school year) 6th - 8th grade students to attend as campers. Members from our high school community (9th-12th grade) will be at camp serving as leaders. Space is limited to 25 campers so please do not wait to register.

How much does EFC Cost? What is the refund policy?

The cost for EFC is \$450. A \$100 deposit is due at registration, but the option to pay in full is available. If you decide to defer payment, you will receive a monthly email with a reminder of your remaining balance. Payment for camp should be complete by May 24th, 2024.

If your child is no longer able to attend camp, any payments are eligible for a refund up to May 1st, 2024 at which point our costs are committed and we are no longer able to provide refunds. Refunds after this date due to illness, injury, or other unforeseen circumstances will be allowed only if we can find a camper to fill your spot. All cancellations and refunds must be submitted in writing via email.

What if all the spots fill up?

If our camp spots fill up and you have a camper interested in attending, please email Carly and you'll be placed on a waiting list. If you are next in the queue and a spot becomes available, you will have 72 hours to claim the spot. After that, the spot will be offered to the next person in the queue. *Please understand that we are limited in space and are not able to make **any** exceptions or move campers ahead in line.*

Who will be leading the activities at camp?

All of the high action activities (zip line, archery, etc.) will be directed by camp staff. The talks and daily teachings will be done by either Youth Ministers from the parishes of camp. Small group sessions will be led by our high school leaders and supervised by an adult leader.

Does Epiphany need help?

The success of camp relies heavily on volunteers. Below are some ways in which you can help with EFC.

- Pray for our middle school campers, high school leaders, and adult volunteers that we may encounter the Lord in new, beautiful ways.
